














Vulture		Humans	Known to hunt fish, reptiles and small mammals.	Incubation is 30 to 50 days.
Elephant		Humans	Grasses, fruits, roots, and bark, and they roam across large distances foraging for food.	Tallness: 11 feet
Giraffe		Humans, Lions, Crocodiles	It will eat grass and fruits of various trees and shrubs,	Have long long necks

African Hare		Humans	Hares eat leaves, buds, roots, berries, fungi, bark, and twigs.	Live in the wooded savanna
Hippo		Human, Lions, Crocodiles	They will eat about 80 pounds of food during this time.	Herbivorous
Rhino		Human	including leaves; buds; and shoots of plants, bushes, and trees.	Live 35 to 40 years old.
Vervet monkey		Leopards, Eagles	Leaves and young shoots are most important in the vervet diet, but bark, flowers, fruit, bulbs, roots, and grass seeds are also consumed.	18-26 in
Zebra		Lions, cheetahs, hyenas, hunting dogs, leopards, humans	Grevy's zebras are extremely mobile grazers, and they can digest many types, and parts, of plants that cattle cannot.	Habitat Grasslands and savannas

Hedgehog		Large birds, most carnivores	It is also known to eat eggs, small mammals, birds, frogs, reptiles, fruit, fungi, and roots.	1-2 lbs
Hyena		humans	The spotted hyena is a skillful hunter but also an opportunistic scavenger. It consumes animals of various types and sizes, carrion, bones, vegetable matter, and other animals' droppings.	28-35 in tall
Ostrich		Humans, cheetahs, lions, leopards, hunting dogs, spotted hyena	They feed on grasses, shrubbery, berries, seeds, and succulents.	Biggest eyeball of any mammal
Gazelle		Humans, all major predators	It will eat herbs, foliage, short grasses, and shoots.	Only able to live up to 12 y/o

Genet		Owls, leopards, pythons, humans	the genet is omnivorous and will eat what is most readily available.	4.5 pounds
Aardvark		Humans, lions, leopards, hyenas, pythons	Aardvarks are specialized for eating termites.	Live in the dry savanna
